



## **Entry Information**

Entry's Open Friday, March 13th

Entry Close Friday, May 1st.

Entry Fees:

Saturday clinic with animals - \$200 (includes a clinic participant-only showmanship class on Sunday)

Clinic without animals (Audit Only) - \$100

Sunday Show Classes – \$40 per class - \$25 for showmanship

No refunds will be available

## **Arrival & Check In Times** *(ALL CHECK-INS WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE SMAA OFFICE LOCATED NEAR THE HOG RING)*

Clinic participants with animals may start arriving on Friday, May 8, at noon.

Show only animals may arrive Saturday, May 9, at noon

All registered animals must have papers checked by 8 am Sunday, May 10

Friday arrivals may check in between 2 and 5 pm at the SMAA Office (located near the hog ring)

Clinic will begin at 10 am

Sunday show will begin at 10 am

## **Stalling In The Barns**

\*\*\*\*All pens/tie outs must be cleaned before departure\*\*\*\*

Shavings will not be provided. Exhibitors may bring and utilize their own shavings.

All pens and tie-outs MUST be cleaned prior to departure

Animals not participating in the Saturday clinic will be allowed to stall in barns Saturday night. Priority will be given to those participating in the Saturday clinic.

We kindly ask that you clean up your barn tie area, including bedding, trash, feed, and manure, prior to your departure.

Power is limited in the barns. Highly recommended to bring generators as an alternate source of power. Generators must be placed outside of the barns when in use.

## **Camping/Show Out of Trailer Information**

Dry camping spaces and show-out-of-trailer spaces are the same locations on the grounds. Exhibitors wishing to stay overnight must reserve a dry camping space.

If camping spaces are not fully reserved, remaining spaces will be released for Sunday-only show-out-of-trailer use.

Any trailer left on the grounds overnight must reserve and pay for a camping space, even if no one is staying in the trailer. Space is limited.

Spaces will go on sale on April 1<sup>st</sup>

Full weekend – \$120

Overnight – \$75

\*\* Reserved Sunday SOT (Sunday only) spots will be available for \$65 if available

## Parking

Spectator parking will be available around the horse barns near **Gate 7 (Livestock Gate)**.

Parking around the livestock barns, arenas, roadways, and in designated fire lanes is **not permitted**. All roads and fire lanes must remain clear at all times for emergency access.

These restrictions will be **strictly enforced**, and vehicles parked in restricted areas may be required to move or may be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

Trailer parking will be available in designated areas only

## Weigh-In Information

Scales will be in the hog barn, near the sheep/goat arena and behind Lyttle cow palace (steers and heifers only)

All steers and commercial heifers must be weighted in

All market lambs and wether dam ewes must be weighed

All market goats and wether does must be weighed in

All market hogs and crossbred and unregistered gilts must be weighed in

## General Rules/Information

The show office will be located at the SMAA offices near the hog ring.

There will be limited trailer parking for those showing out of their trailers. **ALL TRAILERS** parked overnight will need to pay a one-night camping fee.

All pens must be cleaned out prior to departure.

Exhibitors showing out of their trailers **MUST** leave the area how you found it. **CLEAN UP** all shavings, trash, feed and manure from your area before departure.

Livestock **MUST** be washed in designated areas. **NO** washing in aisles between the stalls or at your trailers.

**NO TRASH** in bedding/manure dump areas

Any animal exhibiting signs of infectious or unsightly conditions will not be permitted to show and will be asked to leave the grounds.

All animals entered in a registered division must have papers and be checked by 9 am Sunday, May 10<sup>th</sup>

Showmanship divisions will be as follows:

Junior Division (9-12), Intermediate Division (13-15), and Senior Division (16-18)

Moms Only Showmanship Class – Open to all moms. No pre-entry required. Animals used for showmanship classes must be entered into at least one division class.
